

PARENT CONTRACT

I have informed myself of course content and requirements in order to determine the suitability of the course for my child, and have taken advantage of opportunities to meet and talk with the tutor(s) and administration prior to registration.

I realize that, by registering my child, I am delegating to the tutor(s) and the administration of New Hope a portion of my parental responsibility for my child's education. Thus, I acknowledge the right of each tutor and/or the administration to establish guidelines or parameters for the following:

- assignments;
- discipline during tutorials and while on New Hope property;
- methodology;
- evaluation of student's work as well as attitude and behavior within the class.

I have read the Student Contract and will hold my child accountable for his/her compliance with its content.

I acknowledge that my child is committed to attending tutorials for at least one semester but preferably for a year, as any withdrawal impacts the tutor's income. I am also committed to paying for all tutorials regardless of my child's absence for any reason.

I understand that **Parent Orientation** is mandatory, i.e. I am required to attend all sessions appropriate to the tutorials for which my child is registered. I will continue to take advantage of all opportunities presented by New Hope to talk with administration and staff or discuss the progress of my student (e.g., Parents' Nights and other informational meetings).

I realize that the success of New Hope tutorials depends upon a partnership between parents and tutors, and I will support the tutor in his/her role as an educator by:

- purchasing necessary texts and materials;
- providing or arranging for transportation and seeing that my child arrives on time;
- encouraging my child to discuss the tutorial from the previous day;
- providing materials or opportunities necessary for the completion of assignments, e.g., transportation to the library, access to encyclopedias or other resources, access to a computer or other means of publishing their work, etc.;
- holding my child accountable for class preparation and timely completion of assignments;
- recognizing the tutor's responsibility to contact me if he/she has concerns about my child's academic performance, behavior, attitude, etc., and my responsibility to work with the tutor and my child to address those concerns.
