

STUDENT CONTRACT

I recognize that it is my responsibility to be informed about the tutorials for which I am registering, that I have read the relevant course descriptions and understand the course content and requirements.

I am committed to attending tutorials for a minimum of one semester. It is my responsibility to attend every tutorial and to arrive on time. In the case of sickness or other situation beyond my control, I will inform my tutor as soon as possible, preferably 24 hours in advance, that I will be absent. I also understand that it is my responsibility to contact the tutor as soon as possible AFTER my absence to obtain information and assignments from that day.

It is my responsibility to complete the assigned work on time, and I understand that late assignments may result in a lowered grade. If I do not understand an assignment, I will immediately ask my tutor for clarification. Likewise, if I feel that I need more time to do an assignment to the best of my ability, I will discuss my concerns with my tutor BEFORE THE DUE DATE and work with him/her to resolve the situation.

I will read the **Parent/Student Handbook** and agree to abide by any and all guidelines presented in the booklet, including but not limited to “Student Presence,” “Late/incomplete assignments and lack of preparation,” “Student absences,” “Student attire,” and “Student use of CD players and other entertainment technology.”

I understand that New Hope is a Christian endeavor which upholds a Biblical world view, interpreting and evaluating all subjects in light of Scripture. If I personally do not hold to a Biblical or Christian world view, I understand that I may express my opinions and ask challenging questions in a respectful and thoughtful manner with the expectation of receiving a respectful and thoughtful response.

I understand that New Hope has zero tolerance for illegal drugs or alcohol, and that either possession of such drugs or attending classes while under their influence, will result in my expulsion from New Hope.

I will show respect for the tutor and my peers and will not in any way use my attitude, behavior, speech, or dress to offend them or to infringe on either the tutor’s responsibility to teach or another student’s right to learn.
